### THE COURSE AT A GLANCE

This practical and career-enhancing course, presented by three specialists in the field, provides people involved in the drafting of legislation with essential theoretical and practical knowledge and skills.

This course builds on our introductory short course on legislative drafting. It focuses more intensively on specific issues and problem-solving exercises. On completion, persons will have enhanced knowledge and skills to draft legislation efficiently, accurately and in compliance with legal requirements. Suitable for experienced and inexperienced drafters.
