THE COURSE AT A GLANCE

This 60-hour course is 20 hours longer than standard mediation courses. It has been especially designed to enable lawyers to become mediators and mediation advocates in their spheres of speciality, including commercial, medical negligence, intellectual property, RAF and other matters. This programme includes the newly introduced High Court Rule 41 A and the Department of Justice's court-aligned mediation programme.
