THE COURSE AT A GLANCE

Through this course you will gain an understanding of the principles of contracting, the nature and structure of a contract and the essential contracts, all framed for the needs of a tech-based startup

This course consists of eight hours of online content distributed over three days, and includes live lectures conducted online, reading material and slides. Upon completion of the course, you will have a grounded understanding of the principles of contracting and how they apply to your business.
