THE COURSE AT A GLANCE

Mediation is often a much more affordable option than civil litigation, and it is becoming more commonly accepted as an alternative.

Opportunities for qualified mediators are increasing and this course aims to lay the groundwork for delegates to become skilled mediators in their preferred areas of practice. The course is consistent with international best practice, developed from the combined mediation experience of the course's main presenters. The course is interactive, with a strong emphasis on role-plays, to offer as many learning opportunities as possible. Most of the case studies emanate from real world commercial disputes in South Africa.
